 16 stationed in Twentynine Palms, CA at the Marine Corps Air
 17 Ground Combat Center as a Tank Commander for 3rd Platoon; he

 19 29, 2004 with the 7th Marines 1st Tank Battalion, Charlie
 20 Company; he was expected to return home October 10, 2004; and

 23 Kerri; he also enjoyed playing pool, going to rodeos, camping,
 24 and listening to country music; his greatest joy was coming
