AN ACT in relation to environmental safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended
by changing Section 9.2 as follows:

7 Sec. 9.2. Sulfur dioxide emission standards.

8 (a) (Blank.)

(b) In granting any alternative emission standard or 9 variance relating to sulfur dioxide emissions from a 10 coal-burning stationary source, the Board may require the use 11 of Illinois coal as a condition of the such alternative 12 standard or variance, provided that the Board determines that 13 14 Illinois coal of the proper quality is available and competitive in price; such determination shall include 15 16 consideration of the cost of pollution control equipment and the economic impact on the Illinois coal mining industry. 17 (Source: P.A. 92-574, eff. 9-26-02.) 18
