- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 6-205.2 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/6-205.2 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6-205.2. Mandatory revocation of license or permit</u>
- 8 <u>pending court disposition.</u>
- 9 (a) Within 72 hours of charging any person with reckless
- 10 <u>homicide resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle, the</u>
- 11 State's Attorney must notify the Secretary of State of those
- 12 <u>charges</u>.
- 13 (b) The Secretary, upon receiving notification from the
- 14 State's Attorney, must revoke the driver's license of the
- person against whom the charges are pending.
- (c) The State's Attorney must notify the Secretary of
- 17 the final disposition of the case of any person who has been
- 18 <u>denied a driver's license under subsection (b). If the</u>
- 19 <u>individual whose driving privileges have been revoked under</u>
- 20 <u>this Section is adjudicated guilty, the revocation previously</u>
- 21 <u>entered must remain in effect. If the individual whose</u>
