- 5 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 6 HIV Education for Pregnant Women Act.
- 7 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 8 "AIDS" means acquired immune deficiency syndrome, as
- 9 defined from time to time by the Centers for Disease Control
- 10 and Prevention of the U.S. Public Health Service.
- "Department" means the Illinois Department of Public

- 13 "HIV" means the human immunodeficiency virus and any
- other identified causative agent of AIDS.
- 15 Section 10. Information; counseling.
- 16 (a) A physician or other health care practitioner who is
- 17 the primary caregiver for a woman who seeks care or treatment
- 18 while pregnant or within 4 weeks of giving birth shall
- 19 provide the woman with information about HIV and AIDS and the
- 20 benefits of being tested for HIV and shall inform her of the
- 21 option of being tested anonymously or confidentially.
- (b) No woman shall be tested unless she has provided
- 23 written, informed consent, as provided by the AIDS

- 8 concerning the available medical interventions to prevent the
