- 1 AN ACT concerning park districts.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Park District Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5-2e as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 1205/5-2e new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5-2e. Park district property within municipality</u>
- 8 with recreation board; disconnection. Whenever any property
- 9 <u>within a park district created under this Code also lies</u>
- 10 <u>within the boundaries of a municipality that has established</u>
- 11 <u>a recreation board under Section 11-95-3 of the Illinois</u>
- 12 <u>Municipal Code and the property is being taxed by both the</u>
- 13 park district and the municipality for recreation services,
- 14 10% or more of the legal voters residing within the territory
- 15 may propose to be disconnected and may file a petition with
- 16 the circuit court for the county that contains the largest
- 17 portion of the territory to cause the question to be
- 18 <u>submitted to the legal voters of the territory proposed to be</u>
- 19 <u>disconnected</u>.
- 20 The court shall order the question of disconnection
- 21 <u>submitted to the electors residing in the territory. The</u>
- 22 <u>Clerk of the Circuit Court shall certify the question to the</u>
- 23 proper election authorities at an election in accordance with
- 24 <u>the general election law for submission.</u>
- 25 <u>The question cast at this election shall be in</u>
- 26 <u>substantially the following form:</u>
- 27 <u>Shall the (describe territory) be disconnected from</u>
- 28 <u>(name of park district)?</u>
- The votes shall be recorded as "Yes" or "No".
- 30 <u>If a majority of the electors voting upon the</u>
- 31 <u>disconnection</u> <u>question</u> <u>vote</u> <u>for</u> <u>disconnection</u>; <u>the</u>

- disconnection shall be effective.
- 2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 3 becoming law.
