- 4 Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 6.6 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 205/6.6 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6.6. Office of Immigrant Assistance.</u>
- 8 (a) There is in the Office of the Attorney General the
- 9 Office of Immigrant Assistance. The Office of Immigrant
- 10 Assistance shall provide education and outreach services to
- 11 <u>the resident immigrant community of the State. These services</u>
- 12 shall include, but not be limited to, developing and
- disseminating information regarding the laws that protect the
- 14 rights of consumers, the rights of employees, the civil
- 15 rights of residents of the State, and other relevant laws
- 16 <u>enforced</u> and services provided by the Office of the Attorney
- 17 <u>General</u>.
- 18 (b) The information developed by the Office of Immigrant
- 19 <u>Assistance shall be printed or broadcast in any language</u>
- 20 <u>deemed necessary to reach immigrant communities. Staff of the</u>
- 21 Office of Immigrant Assistance shall also provide assistance
- 22 <u>in any language deemed necessary to service immigrant</u>
- 23 <u>communities.</u>
- 24 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
