AN ACT concerning the Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)

7 Sec. 1. Transition. When at any general election for the office of Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, 8 the Governor, within 2 weeks after such election, shall 9 provide space for not more than 5 persons designated by the 10 Governor-elect to enable the Governor-elect to begin a review 11 and analysis of budgeted expenditures during the then current 12 13 biennium and budget requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a working knowledge of the various offices, 14 departments, commissions, boards and other agencies of the 15 16 executive branch of the State government. The Governor shall cooperate with the Governor-elect and the staff so designated 17 by him and provide any assistance that may be reasonably 18 19 requested.
