- 6 (i) "Legal Advocacy Service attorney" means an attorney
- 7 employed by or under contract with the Legal Advocacy
- Service. 8
- 9 (j) "Service provider" means any public or private
- facility, center, hospital, clinic, program, or any other 10
- person devoted in whole or in part to providing services to 11
- eligible persons. 12
- (k) "State Guardian" means the Office of State Guardian. 13
- 14 (1) "Ward" means a ward as defined by the Probate Act of
- 1975, as now or hereafter amended, who is at least 18 years 15
- 16 of age.
