- If, as of the effective date of Section 13-408 and this Section, an individual telecommunications carrier uses unbundled network elements leased from a specific incumbent local exchange carrier to provide local exchange service over more than 35,000 voice grade equivalent access lines, that carrier must designate the 35,000 voice grade equivalent access lines to which the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this Section apply. If subsequent to such designation, the individual carrier loses the customer served by a designated access line, and therefore no longer leases the unbundled network elements associated with that line, individual carrier may not designate a different access line to substitute for the lost line. All unbundled network elements leased to provide service over undesignated voice grade equivalent access lines shall be subject to the full monthly recurring rates established by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of Section 13-408.
- 2.1 (d) If, as of the effective date of this Section, 22 individual carrier uses unbundled network elements leased 23 from a specific local exchange carrier to provide local fewer than 35,000 voice grade 24 exchange service over 25 equivalent access lines, that carrier must designate the access lines to which the provisions of subsections (a) and 26 (b) of this Section apply. If subsequent to such designation, 27 the individual carrier loses the customer served by a 28 29 designated access line, and therefore no longer leases the 30 unbundled network elements associated with that line, the individual carrier may not designate a different access line 31 32 substitute for the lost line. Subject to these t.o 33 limitations, subsequent to the effective date of this 34 Section, such a carrier may designate additional voice grade
