- 5 27-20.7 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 27-20.7. Asian History Study.</u>
- 8 (a) Every public elementary school and high school shall
- 9 <u>include</u> in its curriculum a unit of instruction studying the
- 10 events of Asian History, including South Asia and the Pacific
- 11 <u>Islands. These events shall include not only the</u>
- 12 <u>contributions made by individual Asian-Americans in</u>
- 13 government and in the arts, humanities, and sciences to the
- 14 <u>economic</u>, <u>cultural</u>, <u>and political development of the United</u>
- 15 <u>States and Asia but also the struggle that Asian-Americans</u>
- 16 <u>experience collectively in striving to achieve fair and equal</u>
- 17 <u>treatment under the laws of this nation. The studying of this</u>
- 18 <u>material shall constitute an affirmation by students of their</u>
- 19 commitment to respect the dignity of all races and peoples
- 20 and to forever eschew every form of discrimination in their
- 21 <u>lives and careers.</u>
- 22 <u>(b) The State Superintendent of Education may prepare</u>
