AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
10-20.37 and 34-18.26 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.37 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.37. Summer kindergarten. A school board may 8 establish, maintain, and operate, in connection with the kindergarten program of the school district, a summer 9 kindergarten program that begins 2 months before the 10 beginning of the regular school year and a summer 11 12 kindergarten program for grade one readiness for those pupils making unsatisfactory progress during the regular 13 kindergarten session that will continue for 2 months after 14 the regular school year. The summer kindergarten program may 15 be held within the school district or, pursuant to a contract 16 17 that must be approved by the State Board of Education, may be operated by 2 or more adjacent school districts or by a 18 19 public or private university or college. Transportation for 20 students attending the summer kindergarten program shall be the responsibility of the school district. The expense of 21 establishing, maintaining, and operating the summer 22 23 kindergarten program may be paid from funds contributed or otherwise made available to the school district for that 24 purpose by federal or State appropriation or from district 25 26 maintenance funds.

 Sec. 34-18.26. Summer kindergarten. The board may
 establish, maintain, and operate, in connection with the
 kindergarten program of the school district, a summer

1	kindergarten program that begins 2 months before the
2	beginning of the regular school year and a summer
3	kindergarten program for grade one readiness for those pupils
4	making unsatisfactory progress during the regular
5	kindergarten session that will continue for 2 months after
6	the regular school year. The summer kindergarten program may
7	be held within the school district or, pursuant to a contract
8	that must be approved by the State Board of Education, may be
9	<u>operated by 2 or more adjacent school districts or by a</u>
10	public or private university or college. Transportation for
11	students attending the summer kindergarten program shall be
12	the responsibility of the school district. The expense of
13	establishing, maintaining, and operating the summer
14	kindergarten program may be paid from funds contributed or
15	otherwise made available to the school district for that
16	purpose by federal or State appropriation or from district
17	<u>maintenance funds.</u>

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 19 becoming law.
