- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3-2 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/3-2) (from Ch. 23, par. 3-2)
- 7 Sec. 3-2. Conditions for basic maintenance grants to
- 8 persons receiving institutional care. A resident of a
- 9 public or private home or institution maintained for the care
- of persons who are sick, convalescent, infirm or chronically
- 11 ill, may, if otherwise qualified, be granted financial aid
- 12 for basic maintenance, subject to the rules and regulations
- of the Illinois Department, if the facilities of the home or
- 14 institution are in conformity with standards prescribed by
- 15 the Department of Public Health for safeguarding the health,
- 16 safety, and comfort of the residents of the home or
- 17 <u>institution</u> thereof, and provide such services as may be
- 18 prescribed by the Illinois Department for enhancing their
- 19 rehabilitation or increasing their capacity for self-care.
