- 1 AN ACT concerning commemorative dates.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended
- 5 by adding Section 63 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/63 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 63. Juneteenth National Freedom Day. The third</u>
- 8 Saturday in June of each year is designated as Juneteenth
- 9 <u>National Freedom Day to commemorate the abolition of slavery</u>
- 10 <u>throughout the United States and its territories in 1865.</u>
- Juneteenth National Freedom Day may be observed with suitable
- observances and exercises by civic groups and the public, and
- 13 <u>citizens of the State are urged to reflect on the suffering</u>
- 14 <u>endured by early African-Americans and to celebrate the</u>
- 15 <u>unique freedom and equality enjoyed by all State citizens</u>
- 16 <u>today</u>.
