- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 7.20 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 70/7.20 new)
- 7 Sec. 7.20. Veal calves. Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 8 <u>Section 13 of this Act, no person may raise a calf for the</u>
- 9 production of veal unless:
- 10 (1) The calf is raised in an enclosure without any
- 11 <u>impairment such as chaining or tethering and of</u>
- 12 <u>sufficient size to permit the calf to be free to turn</u>
- 13 <u>around without difficulty, lie with its legs</u>
- outstretched, and groom itself.
- 15 <u>(2) The calf is fed a daily diet containing</u>
- 16 <u>sufficient iron to prevent anemia and to maintain good</u>
- health and vigor.
- 18 (3) If the calf if more than 14 days old, it is
- 19 <u>provided each day with food containing sufficient</u>
- 20 <u>digestible fiber to prevent the impairment of the</u>
- 21 <u>development of its rumen.</u>
- 22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect 14
- 23 days after becoming law.
