AN ACT concerning child care facilities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by 5 adding Section 5.6 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 10/5.6 new)

Sec. 5.6. Pesticide application at child care facilities. 7 8 Child care facilities must maintain a registry of parents and 9 guardians of children who have registered to receive written notification before the application of pesticides to the 10 facility or provide written notification to all parents and 11 guardians of children before such pesticide application. 12 Written notification may be included in newsletters, 13 bulletins, calendars, or other correspondence currently 14 published by the facility. The written notification must be 15 given at least 2 business days before application of the 16 pesticide and should identify the intended date of the 17 application of the pesticide and the name and telephone 18 19 contact number for the personnel responsible for the pesticide application program. Prior written notice shall 20 not be required if there is imminent threat to health or 21 property. If such a situation arises, the appropriate 22 23 personnel must sign a statement describing the circumstances that gave rise to the health threat and ensure that written 24 notice is provided as soon as practicable. 25

26 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on 27 January 1, 2004.
