- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 6-315 as follows:
- 6 (605 ILCS 5/6-315) (from Ch. 121, par. 6-315)
- Sec. 6-315. An entry in the records, ledger, or official
- 8 <u>minute book</u> of the district clerk, <u>stating that there has</u>
- 9 been a dedication of a public highway according to statutory
- 10 <u>requirements</u> or-a-certified-copy-of-such-record--and--papers,
- 11 relating--to--laying-out,-alteration,-widening-or-vacation-of
- 12 any-township-or-district-road shall be prima facie evidence
- in all cases that there was a dedication of a public highway
- 14 and that the dedication complied with all statutory
- 15 requirements, regardless of whether supporting records or
- 16 <u>documentation of the dedication is available</u> all---the
- 17 necessary--antecedent-provisions-have-been-complied-with,-and
- 18 that-the-action-of-the-highway-commissioner-or-other--persons
- 19 and-officers,-in-regard-thereto,-was-regular-in-all-respects.
