AN ACT concerning highway advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. The Highway Advertising Control Act of 1971
is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 440/10) (from Ch. 121, par. 510)

Sec. 10. <u>Unlawful signs.</u> The following signs are
unlawful and a public <u>nuisances</u> nuisance:

9 (a) Signs erected after the effective date of this Act10 in violation of this Act;

(b) Signs not registered in accordance with this Act or in accordance with the regulations established by the Department;

14 (c) Signs without valid permits, as required by this Act
15 or by regulations established by the Department;

16 (d) Signs advertising alcoholic beverages or tobacco 17 products located within 1,000 feet of any elementary or 18 secondary school.

Each sign declared by this Section to be unlawful and a 19 20 public nuisance shall be removed or brought into compliance with this Act by the owner, without compensation, within 30 21 22 days after receipt of notice by certified mail from the Department, such notice period to be computed from the date 23 If the unlawful sign is affixed to a motor 24 of mailing. vehicle or a trailer or other vehicle capable of being 25 propelled by a motor vehicle, it shall be removed by the 26 27 owner, without compensation, within 24 hours after verbal notice by the Department. Any signs not so removed by the 28 29 owners or any such signs which are removed and re-erected illegally by the owners shall become the property of the 30 State and shall be removed and disposed of by the Department 31

or may be painted over by the Department. The Department is 1 2 also granted authority to enter upon private property for 3 these purposes. If the name and address of the owner of the 4 sign cannot be ascertained from the records of the Department or from a visual inspection of the sign, notices provided for 5 by this Section foregoing-notice-provisions are not required б 7 and the Department shall take immediate action to remove or paint over the sign. 8
