

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "An Act making appropriations", Public Act  
5 93-115, as vetoed, reduced, and restored, is amended by
