AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:


#### Abstract

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 4-23 as follows: (305 ILCS 5/4-23 new) Sec. 4-23. Civil rights impact statement. The Department of Human Services must submit to the Governor and the General Assembly annually on January 1 a written report that details the disparate impact of various provisions of the TANF program on Whites, Blacks/African Americans, and Latinos. The report must at least compare the number of persons in each group:


(1) who are receiving TANF assistance;
(2) whose 60-month lifetime limit on receiving assistance has expired;
(3) who have left TANF due to earned income;
(4) who have left TANF due to non-compliance with program rules;
(5) whose TANF grants have been reduced by sanctions for non-compliance with program rules;
(6) who have returned to TANF 6 months after leaving due to earned income;
(7) who have returned to TANF 12 months after leaving due to earned income;
(8) who have one or more children excluded from receiving TANF cash assistance due to the child exclusion rule;
(9) who have been granted an exemption from work requirements; and
(10) who are participating in post-secondary

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
education activities. becoming law.
