- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:
- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
  adding Section 4-23 as follows:

б (305 ILCS 5/4-23 new) Sec. 4-23. Civil rights impact statement. The Department 7 8 of Human Services must submit to the Governor and the General Assembly annually on January 1 a written report that details 9 the disparate impact of various provisions of the TANF 10 program on Whites, Blacks/African Americans, and Latinos. The 11 12 report must at least compare the number of persons in each 13 <u>group:</u> 14 (1) who are receiving TANF assistance; (2) whose 60-month lifetime limit on receiving 15 16 assistance has expired; (3) who have left TANF due to earned income; 17 (4) who have left TANF due to non-compliance with 18 19 program rules; 20 (5) whose TANF grants have been reduced by sanctions for non-compliance with program rules; 21 (6) who have returned to TANF 6 months after 22 23 <u>leaving due to earned income;</u> (7) who have returned to TANF 12 months after 24 leaving due to earned income; 25 26 (8) who have one or more children excluded from 27 receiving TANF cash assistance due to the child exclusion 28 rule; 29 (9) who have been granted an exemption from work 30 requirements; and (10) who are participating in post-secondary 31
