- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 4-23 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/4-23 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 4-23. Civil rights impact statement. The Department</u>
- 8 of Human Services must submit to the Governor and the General
- 9 Assembly on January 1 of each even-numbered year a written
- 10 report that details the disparate impact of various
- 11 provisions of the TANF program on Whites, Blacks/African
- 12 Americans, and Latinos. The report must at least compare the
- 13 <u>number of persons in each group:</u>
- (1) who are receiving TANF assistance;
- 15 (2) whose 60-month lifetime limit on receiving
- 16 <u>assistance has expired;</u>
- 17 (3) who have left TANF due to earned income;
- 18 <u>(4) who have left TANF due to non-compliance with</u>
- 19 <u>program rules;</u>
- 20 <u>(5) whose TANF grants have been reduced by</u>
- 21 <u>sanctions for non-compliance with program rules;</u>
- 22 (6) who have returned to TANF 6 months after
- 23 <u>leaving due to earned income;</u>

- 27 <u>receiving TANF cash assistance due to the child exclusion</u>
- 28 <u>rule;</u>
- 29 <u>(9) who have been granted an exemption from work</u>

- 31 (10) who are participating in post-secondary

- 1 <u>education activities.</u>
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 2
