AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
5 adding Section 5-24 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-24 new)

Sec. 5-24. Pediatric asthma initiative. During the 2004 7 fiscal year, the Department of Public Aid shall begin an 8 initiative to prevent and treat pediatric asthma. Under the 9 initiative, the Department shall contract with health care 10 providers for programs for the prevention and treatment of 11 12 pediatric asthma through physician and patient education and 13 case management. The Department shall contract with providers of health care services that the Department has determined 14 are qualified, under criteria developed in rules, to deliver 15 the proposed program model, providing care consistent with 16 the 1997 guidelines on asthma from the National Institutes of 17 Health. The Department shall enter into these contracts in 18 19 the county or counties that have the highest volume or highest rate, compared to national averages, of 20 hospitalization or mortality, or both, from pediatric asthma 21 22 according to criteria specified by the Department in rules 23 and as resources permit, provided that these criteria must specify, at a minimum, that a grant or grants shall be made 24 each year in counties exceeding 3,000,000 in population. 25

26 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 27 becoming law.
