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AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Personnel Code is amended by changing
Section 4c as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 415/4c) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b104c)

Sec. 4c. General exemptions. The following positions in
State service shall be exempt from jurisdictions A, B, and C,
unless the jurisdictions shall be extended as provided in
this Act:

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(1) All officers elected by the people.

12 (2) All positions under the Lieutenant Governor,
13 Secretary of State, State Treasurer, State Comptroller,
14 State Board of Education, Clerk of the Supreme Court, and
15 Attorney General.

16 (3) Judges, and officers and employees of the17 courts, and notaries public.

18 (4) All officers and employees of the Illinois
19 General Assembly, all employees of legislative
20 commissions, all officers and employees of the Illinois
21 Legislative Reference Bureau, the Legislative Research
22 Unit, and the Legislative Printing Unit.

(5) All positions in the Illinois National Guard
and Illinois State Guard, paid from federal funds or
positions in the State Military Service filled by
enlistment and paid from State funds.

27 (6) All employees of the Governor at the executive
28 mansion and on his immediate personal staff.

29 (7) Directors of Departments, the Adjutant General,
30 the Assistant Adjutant General, the Director of the
31 Illinois Emergency Management Agency, members of boards

1 2 and commissions, and all other positions appointed by the Governor by and with the consent of the Senate.

(8) The presidents, other principal administrative 3 4 officers, and teaching, research and extension faculties of Chicago State University, Eastern Illinois University, 5 Governors State University, Illinois State University, 6 7 Northeastern Illinois University, Northern Illinois 8 University, Western Illinois University, the Illinois 9 Community College Board, Southern Illinois University, Illinois Board of Higher Education, University of 10 11 Illinois, State Universities Civil Service System, University Retirement System of Illinois, and the 12 administrative officers and scientific and technical 13 staff of the Illinois State Museum. 14

15 (9) All other employees except the presidents, 16 other principal administrative officers, and teaching, research and extension faculties of the universities 17 under the jurisdiction of the Board of Regents and the 18 colleges and universities under the jurisdiction of the 19 Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities, 20 21 Illinois Community College Board, Southern Illinois University, Illinois Board of Higher Education, Board of 22 23 Governors of State Colleges and Universities, the Board of Regents, University of Illinois, State Universities 24 Civil Service System, University Retirement System of 25 Illinois, so long as these are subject to the provisions 26 of the State Universities Civil Service Act. 27

(10) The State Police so long as they are subject
to the merit provisions of the State Police Act.

30 (11) The scientific staff of the State Scientific
 31 Surveys and the Waste Management and Research Center.

32 (12) The technical and engineering staffs of the
 33 Department of Transportation, the Department of Nuclear
 34 Safety, the Pollution Control Board, and the Illinois

Commerce Commission, and the technical and engineering
 staff providing architectural and engineering services in
 the Department of Central Management Services.

4 (13) All employees of the Illinois State Toll 5 Highway Authority. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority shall 6 7 not employ any individual who has been or is convicted of 8 any of the following crimes, as defined in the Criminal 9 Code of 1961 and the Illinois Vehicle Code: armed robbery, robbery, vehicular hijacking, aggravated 10 vehicular hijacking, aggravated robbery, burglary, 11 12 residential burglary, home invasion, theft from a motor vehicle, theft of motor vehicle parts or accessories, 13 burglary of motor vehicle parts or accessories, burglary 14 15 from a motor vehicle, vehicular invasion, theft, retail 16 theft, delivery container theft, theft from coin-operated machines, motor vehicle theft, embezzlement, or money 17 laundering. 18

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(14) The Secretary of the Industrial Commission.

20 (15) All persons who are appointed or employed by the Director of Insurance under authority of Section 202 21 of the Illinois Insurance Code to assist the Director of 22 23 Insurance in discharging his responsibilities relating to the rehabilitation, 24 liquidation, conservation, and 25 dissolution of companies that are subject to the jurisdiction of the Illinois Insurance Code. 26

27 (16) All employees of the St. Louis Metropolitan
28 Area Airport Authority.

29 (17) All investment officers employed by the30 Illinois State Board of Investment.

(18) Employees of the Illinois Young Adult
 Conservation Corps program, administered by the Illinois
 Department of Natural Resources, authorized grantee under
 Title VIII of the Comprehensive Employment and Training

1 Act of 1973, 29 USC 993.

2 (19) Seasonal employees of the Department of 3 Agriculture for the operation of the Illinois State Fair 4 and the DuQuoin State Fair, no one person receiving more 5 than 29 days of such employment in any calendar year.

6 (20) All "temporary" employees hired under the 7 Department of Natural Resources' Illinois Conservation 8 Service, a youth employment program that hires young 9 people to work in State parks for a period of one year or 10 less.

11 (21) All hearing officers of the Human Rights12 Commission.

13 (22) All employees of the Illinois Mathematics and14 Science Academy.

15 (23) All employees of the Kankakee River Valley16 Area Airport Authority.
