

1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,  
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by  
5 adding Section 5-9-1.12 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 5/5-9-1.12 new)

7 Sec. 5-9-1.12. Applications for transfer to other  
8 states. A person subject to conditions of probation, parole,  
9 or mandatory supervised release who seeks to transfer to  
10 another state subject to the Interstate Compact for Adult  
11 Offender Supervision must make provisions for the payment of  
12 any restitution awarded by the circuit court and pay a fee of  
13 \$125 to the proper administrative or judicial authorities  
14 before being granted the transfer, or otherwise arrange for  
15 payment. The fee payment from persons subject to a sentence  
16 of probation shall be deposited into the general fund of the  
17 county in which the circuit has jurisdiction. The fee  
18 payment from persons subject to parole or mandatory  
19 supervised release shall be deposited into the General  
20 Revenue Fund. The proceeds of this fee shall be used to  
21 defray the costs of the Department of Corrections or county  
22 sheriff departments, respectively, who will be required to  
23 retrieve offenders that violate the terms of their transfers  
24 to other states. Upon return to the State of Illinois, these  
25 persons shall also be subject to reimbursing either the State  
26 of Illinois or the county for the actual costs of returning  
27 them to Illinois.
