1 AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by5 adding Section 368b as follows:

б (215 ILCS 5/368b new) 7 Sec. 368b. Prohibition of waiver of requirements and prohibitions. No contract or administrative policy, either 8 formal or informal, shall contain any provision, term, 9 condition, or procedure that limits, restricts, or otherwise 10 waives any of the requirements and prohibitions set forth in 11 this Article. Any provision purporting to make such a waiver 12 13 is void and unenforceable.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effectDecember 1, 2003.
