- 28 may be necessary, and remains unexpended at the close of
- 29 business on June 30, 2003, from appropriations heretofore

- 1 made in Article 44, Section 9 of Public Act 92-538, as
- 2 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois National Guard
- 3 Armory Construction Fund for land acquisition and
- 4 construction of parking facilities at armories.
- 5 Section 10. The sum of \$13,700, or so much thereof as
- 6 may be necessary, and remains unexpended at the close of
- 7 business on June 30, 2003, from appropriations heretofore
- 8 made in Article 44, Section 10 of Public Act 92-538, as
- 9 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois National Guard
- 10 Armory Construction Fund for land acquisition and
- 11 construction of parking facilities at armories.
- 12 Section 11. No contract shall be entered into or
- 13 obligation incurred for any expenditures made from an
- 14 appropriation herein made in Sections 4, 8, and 9 until after
- 15 the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the
- 16 Governor.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on
- 18 July 1, 2003.
