AN ACT concerning utilities.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding Section 16-111.4 as follows:
(220 ILCS 5/16-111.4 new)
Sec. 16-111.4. Public university renewable energy projects.
(a) The Legislature finds and declares that the implementation of renewable energy sources by public universities for their own use can encourage private investment in renewable energy resources, stimulate economic growth, enhance the continued diversification of Illinois' energy resource mix, and protect the environment of Illinois.
(b) The Legislature further finds and declares that the funding of public university renewable energy projects by the Illinois Clean Energy Community Trust is consistent with the Legislature's intent in providing for the Trust in Section 16-111.1 of this Act and, therefore, encourages public universities to request funding of such projects from the Trust and the Trust, consistent with the resources available to the Trust and with the good judgment of its trustees, to grant such requests.
(c) As used in this Section:
"Renewable energy source" means a solar or wind electrical generating facility with a capacity of not more than 1000 kilowatts that is located on the premises of a public university and is intended primarily to offset part or all of the university's own electrical requirements.
"Public university" means Northern Illinois University, Southern Illinois University, Eastern Illinois University,
Western Illinois University, the University of Illinois,

Chicago State University, Governors State University, Illinois State University, or Northeastern Illinois University.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
