AN ACT concerning procurement.

## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by 5 adding Section 25-65 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 500/25-65 new)

7 Sec. 25-65. Contracts performed outside the United States. Prior to contracting or as a requirement of solicitation of any 8 State contracts for services as defined in Section 1-15.90, 9 whichever is appropriate, prospective vendors shall disclose 10 in a statement of work any services under that contract, 11 including any subcontracts, that are anticipated to be 12 performed outside the United States. The Chief Procurement 13 Officer may consider such disclosure in awarding the contract 14 15 or evaluating the bid or offer, provided that such consideration is not inconsistent with any obligation under any 16 international agreement to which the State of Illinois is a 17 party. The Department of Central Management Services shall 18 19 prepare and deliver to the General Assembly, no later than September 1, 2007, a report on the impact of outsourcing 20 services on the State's cost of procurement that identifies 21 those contracts where it was disclosed that services were 22 provided outside of the United States, a description and value 23 of such services. 24
