SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/34-84.5 new 30 ILCS 805/8.28 new

Amends the School Code with regard to the Chicago school district. Provides that teacher seniority shall be based on employment within the school district, not employment at a particular attendance center. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 34-84.5 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 34-84.5. Teacher seniority. Teacher seniority shall</u>
- 8 <u>be based on employment within the school district, not</u>
- 9 employment at a particular attendance center.

- 11 Section 8.28 as follows:
- 12 (30 ILCS 805/8.28 new)
- Sec. 8.28. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
- the 93rd General Assembly.
