Makes appropriations and reappropriations to Northeastern Illinois University for various purposes, including ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
7 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northeastern
8 Illinois University to meet the ordinary and contingent
9 expenses of Northeastern Illinois University for the fiscal
10 year ending June 30, 2005:

11	For Personal Services, including payment or	
12	reimbursement to the University for personal	
13	services and related costs incurred during	
14	the fiscal year	\$ 31,605,900
15	For State Contribution to Social Security for	
16	Medicare	400,000
17	For Group Insurance	1,072,600
18	For Contractual Services	2,500,000
19	For Equipment and Library Books	<u>1,200,000</u>
20	Total	\$36,778,500

21 Section 10. The sum of \$ 250,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
23 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northeastern Illinois
24 University to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
25 the University required to match the Federal Title II Teacher
26 Quality Enhancement State Grant, including payment or
27 reimbursement to the University for personal services and
28 related costs incurred during the fiscal year authorized by
29 law, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005.

30 Section 15. The sum of \$2,083,800, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
2 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore
3 made for such purpose in Article 10, Section 15 of Public Act
4 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to
5 the Board of Trustees of Northeastern Illinois University to
6 purchase equipment and remodel buildings A, B, and E. This
7 appropriation is in addition to any funds previously
8 appropriated.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
10 2004.
