SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/33-6 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Provides that an employee of the Department of Children and Family Services or a foster parent licensed by the Department of Children and Family Services who knowingly falsifies a Department document or who knowingly makes a false statement in a Department document as to a material fact in relation to an investigation of alleged or suspected neglect or abuse of a minor or in relation to an investigation of an alleged dependent minor is guilty of a Class 4 felony. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
Section 33-6 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/33-6 new)

7 Sec. 33-6. Department of Children and Family Services employees or foster parents falsifying records. An employee of 8 the Department of Children and Family Services or a foster 9 parent licensed by the Department of Children and Family 10 Services who knowingly falsifies a document required to be made 11 or kept by the Department or who knowingly makes a false 12 statement in a document required to be made or kept by the 13 Department as to a material fact in relation to an 14 investigation of alleged or suspected neglect or abuse of a 15 minor as defined in Section 2-3 of the Juvenile Court Act of 16 1987 or in relation to an investigation of an alleged dependent 17 minor as defined in Section 2-4 of the Juvenile Court Act of 18 19 1987 is guilty of a Class 4 felony.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
