SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/9-11	from Ch. 46, par. 9-11
10 ILCS 5/9-12	from Ch. 46, par. 9-12
10 ILCS 5/9-13	from Ch. 46, par. 9-13
10 ILCS 5/9-14	from Ch. 46, par. 9-14

Amends the Election Code. With respect to a political committee's disclosure of campaign contributions and expenditures, requires itemization of contributions, expenditures, and transfers exceeding \$1 (now, exceeding \$150).

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AN ACT concerning campaign finance.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing 5 Sections 9-11, 9-12, 9-13, and 9-14 as follows:

Sec. 9-11. Each report of campaign contributions under
Section 9-10 shall disclose-

9 (1) the name and address of the political committee;

10 (2) (Blank);

11 (3) the amount of funds on hand at the beginning of the 12 reporting period;

(4) the full name and mailing address of each person who 13 14 has made one or more contributions to or for such committee 15 within the reporting period in an aggregate amount or value in excess of $\frac{\$1}{\$150}$, together with the amount and date of such 16 17 contributions, and if a contributor is an individual who contributed more than \$500, the occupation and employer of the 18 19 contributor or, if the occupation and employer of the contributor are unknown, a statement that the committee has 20 made a good faith effort to ascertain this information; 21

(5) the total sum of individual contributions made to or for such committee during the reporting period and not reported under item (4);

25 (6) the name and address of each political committee from 26 which the reporting committee received, or to which that 27 committee made, any transfer of funds, in any aggregate amount 28 or value in excess of $\frac{\$1}{\$150}$, together with the amounts and 29 dates of all transfers;

30 (7) the total sum of transfers made to or from such 31 committee during the reporting period and not reported under 32 item (6);

1 (8) each loan to or from any person within the reporting 2 period by or to such committee in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$1 \$150, together with the full names and mailing 3 4 addresses of the lender and endorsers, if any, and the date and 5 amount of such loans, and if a lender or endorser is an individual who loaned or endorsed a loan of more than \$500, the 6 occupation and employer of that individual, or if the 7 8 occupation and employer of the individual are unknown, a statement that the committee has made a good faith effort to 9 10 ascertain this information;

(9) the total amount of proceeds received by such committee from (a) the sale of tickets for each dinner, luncheon, cocktail party, rally, and other fund-raising events; (b) mass collections made at such events; and (c) sales of items such as political campaign pins, buttons, badges, flags, emblems, hats, banners, literature, and similar materials;

(10) each contribution, rebate, refund, or other receipt in excess of <u>\$1</u> \$150 received by such committee not otherwise listed under items (4) through (9), and if a contributor is an individual who contributed more than \$500, the occupation and employer of the contributor or, if the occupation and employer of the contributor are unknown, a statement that the committee has made a good faith effort to ascertain this information;

(11) the total sum of all receipts by or for such committeeor candidate during the reporting period.

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The Board shall by rule define a "good faith effort".

The reports of campaign contributions filed under this Article shall be cumulative during the reporting period to which they relate.
