AN ACT in relation to civil procedure.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 5 changing Section 2-201 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/2-201) (from Ch. 110, par. 2-201)

Sec. 2-201. Commencement of actions; forms of process.

8 (a) Every action, unless otherwise expressly provided by 9 statute, shall be commenced by the filing of a complaint. The 10 clerk shall issue summons upon request of the plaintiff. The 11 form and substance of the summons, and of all other process, 12 and the issuance of alias process, and the service of copies of 13 pleadings shall be according to rules.

(b) One or more duplicate original summonses may be issued, marked "First Duplicate₇", "Second Duplicate₇", and so forth etc., as the case may be, whenever it will facilitate the service of summons in any one or more counties, including the county of venue.
