Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Removes a provision terminating implementation of the Department of Public Aid's waiver of requirements of Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act on June 30, 2007.

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AN ACT concerning public aid.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5-5.12a as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.12a)

7 Sec. 5-5.12a. Title XIX waiver; pharmacy assistance program. The Illinois Department may seek a waiver of otherwise 8 applicable requirements of Title XIX of the federal Social 9 Security Act in order to claim federal financial participation 10 for a pharmacy assistance program for persons aged 65 and over 11 12 with income levels at or less than 250% of the federal poverty level. The Illinois Department may provide by rule for all 13 14 other requirements of the program, including cost sharing, as 15 permitted by an approved waiver and without regard to any provision of this Code to the contrary. The benefits may be no 16 17 more restrictive than the Pharmacy Assistance Program in effect on May 31, 2001. Benefits provided under the waiver are subject 18 19 to appropriation.

The Illinois Department may not implement the waiver until cost neutrality is demonstrated for the State relative to the final Pharmacy Assistance Program appropriation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001. Implementation of the waiver shall terminate on June 30, 2007.
