SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3120/4 from Ch. 127, par. 3504 20 ILCS 3120/5 from Ch. 127, par. 3505

Amends the Asbestos Abatement Authority Act. Renames the Attorney General's Asbestos Litigation Division as the Environmental Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning the Attorney General

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Asbestos Abatement Authority Act is amended
- 5 by changing Sections 4 and 5 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3120/4) (from Ch. 127, par. 3504)
- 7 Sec. 4. Environmental Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation
- 8 Division. There is created within the office of the Attorney
- 9 General an <u>Environmental Enforcement-</u>Asbestos Litigation
- 10 Division. The Division, under the supervision and the direction
- of the Attorney General, shall investigate and initiate legal
- 12 proceedings necessary to ensure maximum recovery of asbestos
- 13 abatement costs for all State entities of this State. All
- 14 amounts recovered by the Division, including those awarded for
- asbestos abatement and attorney's fees, shall be deposited in
- the Asbestos Abatement Fund in the State Treasury.

- 18 (20 ILCS 3120/5) (from Ch. 127, par. 3505)
- 19 Sec. 5. Asbestos Abatement Fund. There is created in the
- 20 State Treasury the Asbestos Abatement Fund into which shall be
- 21 deposited all grants, gifts, attorney's fees and recoveries
- 22 received for the purpose of asbestos abatement in the State
- 23 governmental buildings. Such funds shall be expended pursuant
- 24 to appropriations made by the General Assembly to the Capital
- 25 Development Board for asbestos surveys and abatement purposes
- 26 and to the Attorney General for the operations of the
- 27 Environmental Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division.

- 29 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 30 becoming law.
