Makes appropriations and reappropriations to Northern Illinois University for various purposes, including for ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 5 as and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois 7 University to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 8 9 the University, including payment or reimbursement to the University for personal services and related costs, incurred 10 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005: 11 For Personal Services, including payment 12 to the University for personal service 13 14 and related costs incurred during the fiscal year\$86,202,400 15 For Contractual Services\$6,456,100 16 For Travel\$159,500 17 For Commodities\$1,971,400 18 For Equipment and Library Books\$1,581,500 19 For Operations of Auto Equipment\$138,500 20 For Telecommunications Services\$796,900 21 For Repair, Maintenance, and Other Capital 22 Improvements\$1,560,700 23 24 For Awards and Grants and Matching Funds\$185,700 For State Contributions to Social 25 Security, for Medicare\$408,900 26 For Personnel - Employee Health Insurance\$2,337,300 27 Total \$101,798,900 28

29 Section 10. The sum of \$532,748, or so much thereof as 30 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 31 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore -2- LRB093 18057 NHT 47005 b

made for that purpose in Article 4, Section 40 of Public Act 1 2 93-587, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University for 3 technology infrastructure improvements at Northern Illinois 4 University. No contract shall be entered into or obligation 5 6 incurred for any expenditures from the reappropriation made in this Section until after the purposes and amounts have 7 been approved in writing by the Governor. 8

9 Section 15. The sum of \$43,366, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 11 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore 12 made for that purpose in Article 4, Section 45 of Public Act 13 93-587, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 14 to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University for 15 purchasing Engineering Building equipment.

16 Section 20. The sum of \$10,075, or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and 18 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern 19 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in 20 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2004.
