**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those  
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
6 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student  
7 Assistance Commission for its ordinary and contingent  
8 expenses:

27 Section 30. The following named amount, or so much  
 28 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 29 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 30 Commission for the following purpose:

5 Section 35. The following named amount, or so much  
 6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 7 Monetary Award Program Reserve Fund to the Illinois Student  
 8 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

 12 receive such awards, as provided by

 15 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the

 17 Commission for the following purpose:

22 Section 45. The following named amount, or so much  
 23 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 24 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the  
 25 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
 26 purpose:

27 Grants and Scholarships

28 For payment of scholarships for the  
 29 Optometric Education Scholarship Program,  
 30 as provided by law .....\$50,000

1 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 3 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the  
 4 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
 5 purpose:

 9 Program, as provided by law .....\$50,000

10 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much

 13 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent

1 Section 60. The following named amount, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
 3 Student Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 4 Commission for the following purposes:

5 For distribution when necessary as a result  
 6 of any of the following: for guarantees  
 7 of loans that are uncollectible, for  
 8 collection payments to the Student Loan  
 9 Operating Fund as required under  
 10 agreements with the United States  
 11 Secretary of Education, for payments to  
 12 the Student Loan Operating Fund  
 13 for Default Aversion Fees,  
 14 and for other distributions as necessary and provided  
 15 for under the Federal Higher Education  
 16 Act .....\$190,000,000

17 Section 65. The following named amount, or so much  
 18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student  
 19 Loan Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 20 Commission for the following purposes:

21 For distribution when necessary as a result  
 22 of any of the following: for payment of  
 23 collection agency fees associated with  
 24 collection activities for Federal Family  
 25 Education Loans, for Default Aversion Fee  
 26 reversals, and for other distributions as  
 27 necessary and provided for under the  
 28 Federal Higher Education Act .....\$24,000,000

29 Section 70. The following named amount, or so much  
 30 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student  
 31 Loan Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 32 Commission for the following purpose:

1 For costs associated with Federal Loan  
 2 System Development and Maintenance .....\$5,000,000

3 Section 75. The following named amount, or so much  
 4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
 5 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student  
 6 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

7 For transferring repayment funds collected  
 8 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship  
 9 Program to the U.S. Treasury .....\$400,000

10 Section 80. The following sum, or so much thereof as may  
 11 be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
 12 Incentive Trust Fund for the Federal Leveraging Educational  
 13 Assistance and the Supplemental Leveraging Educational  
 14 Assistance Programs to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 15 Commission for the following purpose:

16 Grants  
 17 For payment of Monetary Award Program  
 18 grants to full-time and part-time  
 19 students eligible to receive such grants,  
 20 as provided by law .....\$0

21 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much  
 22 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
 23 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student  
 24 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

25 For payment of Robert C. Byrd  
 26 Honors Scholarships .....\$1,800,000

27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
 28 2004.
