1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The following named sums, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 6 General Revenue Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy 7 8 Commission for the purposes hereinafter named: For Personal Services 6,182,600 9 For Employee Retirement Contributions 10 Paid by Employer0 11 For State Contributions to the State 12 13 For State Contributions to 14 15 16 17 For Commodities14,000 18 19 20 21 2.2 23 For Operation of Auto Equipment7,600 24 Total \$8,032,400

25 Section 2. The sum of \$187,700, or so much thereof as 26 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Guardianship and 27 Advocacy Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for 28 services pursuant to Section 5 of the Guardianship and 29 Advocacy Act. Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
2004.
