- 3 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL
- 4 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF

- THE EXECUTIVE
- 14 (ILCON Art. V, Sec. 1)
- 15 SECTION 1. OFFICERS
- 16 The Executive Branch shall include a Governor, Lieutenant
- 17 Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, and
- 18 <u>Comptroller of the Treasury</u> Comptroller-and-Treasurer elected
- 19 by the electors of the State. They shall keep the public
- 20 records and maintain a residence at the seat of government
- 21 during their terms of office.

- 24 SECTION 3. ELIGIBILITY
- To be eligible to hold the office of Governor, Lieutenant
- 26 Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, or

- 28 person must be a United States citizen, at least 25 years
- 29 old, and a resident of this State for the three years
- 30 preceding his <u>or her</u> election.

- 3 If the Attorney General, Secretary of State, or

- 6 shall fill the office by appointment. The appointee shall
- 7 hold office until the elected officer qualifies or until a

- by him or her, (ii) be responsible for the safekeeping and
