1 SENATE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, The driver's license is one source of
- 3 identification used in the State of Illinois and elsewhere;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, The general public and the business community of
- 6 Illinois wish to have a driver's license which is secure,
- 7 accurate, and that permits record integrity; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Currently, seven states--California, Colorado,
- 9 Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Texas and West Virginia--collect
- 10 fingerprints at application for a driver's license; West
- 11 Virginia uses facial recognition technology to verify the
- 12 identity of individuals seeking to renew or replace a
- driver's license; and Colorago is planning to implement a
- 14 facial recognition system similar to that used in West
- 15 Virginia later this year; and
- 16 WHEREAS, new biometric technology is now available that
- 17 can verify the identity of individuals based on their unique
- 18 physical characteristics; therefore be it
- 19 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL
- 20 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there is created an
- 21 Illinois Identification Technology Task Force for the purpose
- of researching and evaluating available technologies for the
- 23 identification of driver's license applicants; and be it
- 24 further
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Identification Technology
- 26 Task Force shall consist of the following members: 4 members
- of the Illinois Senate, two of whom shall be appointed by the
- 28 President of the Senate and two of whom shall be appointed by
- 29 the Minority Leader of the Senate; and one member designated
- 30 by the Secretary of State; and be it further
- 31 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Identification Technology
- 32 Task Force shall report its findings to the General Assembly
- and the Secretary of State no later May 1, 2004.
