2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 54 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 27 as follows:

6 (745 ILCS 49/27 new)

7 Sec. 27. Exemption from civil liability for assistance to  
8 law enforcement officers during law enforcement critical  
9 incident, tactical training, or tactical operations. Any  
10 physician licensed under the Medical Practice Act of 1987 to  
11 practice medicine in all its branches or licensed to practice  
12 the treatment of human ailments in any other state or territory  
13 of the United States, any physician assistant licensed under  
14 the Physician Assistant Practice Act of 1987, any nurse  
15 licensed under the Nursing and Advanced Practice Nursing Act,  
16 any paramedic, any emergency medical technician, or any First  
17 Responder who, in good faith and without fee, or with a fee not  
18 to exceed \$1, to a person, provides assistance to a law  
19 enforcement officer while the officer is engaged in law  
20 enforcement critical incident, tactical training, or tactical  
21 operations shall not, as a result of his or her acts or  
22 omissions, except willful or wanton misconduct on the part of  
23 the person, in providing the care, be liable for civil  
24 damages."
