5 "Section 5. The State Vehicle Identification Act is amended

by changing Section 4 and by adding Section 4.5 as follows:

7 (30 ILCS 610/4) (from Ch. 127, par. 133e4)

Sec. 4. <u>Sections 2 and 3</u> This Act shall not apply to 8 vehicles used by elective State officers, by executive heads of 9 State agencies and departments, by presidents of colleges or 10 universities placed under control of officers of this State, or 11 by any employee of a State agency or department in the 12 performance of investigative services exclusively when the 13 executive head thereof has requested an exception in writing, 14 15 and such exception has been approved in writing by the 16 Department, on the basis that the identification would hamper 17 the individual employee in the routine performance of his 18 investigative duties. A record, open to public inspection, shall be kept by the Department of all such exceptions approved 19

Sections 2 and 3 This Act shall not apply to vehicles assigned to the use of the Department of State Police and the Division of Law Enforcement of the Department of Natural Resources, and the executive heads thereof shall have within

- their discretion determination of the type of markings or 1
- identification, if any, to be affixed to vehicles assigned to 2
- 3 said Department or Division nor shall <u>Sections 2 and 3</u> this Act
- 4 apply to vehicles assigned to the use of Secretary of State
- 5 police officers.

- Sec. 4.5. Identifying markings. 8
- (a) In order that vehicles are identifiable as State 9
- 10 property, each vehicle owned by the State shall bear
- identifying markings on the front, side, or rear of the vehicle 11
- and the markings may include the use of window decals. Decals 12
- 13 and markings shall have a small State seal and the name of the
- 14 State agency using the vehicle.
- (b) A State agency shall make exemptions to the requirement 15
- of subsection (a) for reasonable security purposes by adoption 16
- of rules in accordance with the Illinois Administrative 17
- Procedure Act. Agencies making exemptions shall notify the 18
- Department of Central Management Services. The Department 19
- 20 shall maintain a list of exemptions from the requirement of
- 21 subsection (a). The listing shall not be made available to the
- public and is exempt from the disclosure requirements of 22
- Section 7 of the Freedom of Information Act. 23
- 24 (c) This Section does not apply to vehicles assigned to
- 25 members of the General Assembly and employees of the
- legislative branch of State government. 26
- 27 (d) This Section shall not apply to vehicles assigned to
- 28 the use of the Department of State Police and the Division of
- Law Enforcement of the Department of Natural Resources, and the 29
- executive heads thereof have within their discretion 30
- determination of the type of markings or identification, if 31
- 32 any, to be affixed to vehicles assigned to that Department or
- Division. This Section shall not apply to vehicles assigned to 33

the use of the Secretary of State police officers.".
