These events shall 2 3 include not only the contributions made by individual 4 African-Americans in government and in the arts, humanities and 5 sciences to the economic, cultural and political development of the United States and Africa, but also the socio-economic 6 7 struggle which African-Americans experienced collectively in 8 striving to achieve fair and equal treatment under the laws of this nation. The studying of this material shall constitute an 9 10 affirmation by students of their commitment to respect the dignity of all races and peoples and to forever eschew every 11 12 form of discrimination in their lives and careers.

13 The State Superintendent of Education may prepare and make 14 available to all school boards instructional materials_ 15 including those established by the Amistad Commission, which may be used as guidelines for development of a unit of 16 instruction under this Section; provided, however, that each 17 18 school board shall itself determine the minimum amount of 19 instruction time which shall qualify as a unit of instruction 20 satisfying the requirements of this Section.
