## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 3. The Illinois Identification Card Act is amended by adding Section 14D as follows:

- Sec. 14D. Limitations on use of identification card information.
- (a) When information is obtained from an identification 9 card issued by the Secretary of State to identify or prove the 10 age of the holder of the card, or in the course of a commercial 11 transaction, that information may be used only for purposes of 12 identification of the individual or for completing the 13 commercial transaction in which the information was obtained. 14 15 Information obtained from an identification card issued by the Secretary of State may not be used for purposes unrelated to 16 the transaction in which it was obtained, including, but not 17 limited to, commercial solicitations. Information obtained 18 from an identification card issued by the Secretary of State to 19 identify or prove the age of the holder of the card, or in the 20 21 course of a commercial transaction, may not be sold, leased or 22 otherwise provided to any third party.
  - (b) As used in this Section, "information" on an identification card issued by the Secretary of State includes readable text on the face of the card and information encoded or encrypted into a bar code, magnetic strip, or other electronically readable device on or in the card.
- 28 <u>(c) Any individual whose identification card information</u>
  29 <u>has been used in violation of this Section has a cause of</u>
  30 <u>action against the person who violated this Section. Upon a</u>

- 17 <u>Sec. 6-117.1. Prohibited use of driver's license</u>
- 18 <u>information</u>.
- 19 (a) When information is obtained from a driver's license to
- identify or prove the age of the holder of the license, or in
- 21 <u>the course of a commercial transaction, that information may be</u>
- 22 <u>used only for purposes of identification of the individual or</u>
- 23 <u>for completing the commercial transaction in which the</u>
- 24 <u>information was obtained. Information obtained from a driver's</u>
