(a) Driver's licenses, State issued identification cards, 9 social security account cards, or other government issued 10 identification documents in possession of a county sheriff at 11 the time a person is committed to the Illinois Department of 12 Corrections shall be forwarded to the Department. 13 14 (b) The Department shall retain the government issued identification documents of a committed person at the 15 16 institution in which the person is incarcerated and shall ensure that the documents are forwarded to any institution to 17 18 which the person is transferred. (c) The government issued identification documents of a 19 committed person shall be made available to the person upon 20 21 discharge from the Department.".
