A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
9 Agency:

18 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and
19 grants for historic preservation programs made either
20 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government
21 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or
22 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
23 private corporation, organization, or individual.

25 Section 27. The sum of \$136,147, or so much thereof as
26 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
27 business on June 30, 2005, from an appropriation heretofore
28 made for such purpose in Article 33, Section 25 of Public Act
29 93-0842, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites
30 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and
31 grants for historic preservation programs made either
32 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government
33 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or

1 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
2 private corporation, organization, or individual.

3 Section 30. The sum of \$89,423, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of
5 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
6 made in Article 33, Section 30 of Public Act 93-0842, as
7 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites
8 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and
9 grants for historic preservation programs made either
10 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government
11 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or
12 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
13 private corporation, organization, or individual.

14 Section 35. The sum of \$1,566, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of
16 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
17 made in Article 33, Section 35 of Public Act 93-0842, as
18 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites
19 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and
20 grants for historic preservation programs made either
21 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government
22 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or
23 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
24 private corporation, organization, or individual.

25 Section 40. The sum of \$23,764, or so much thereof as
26 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of
27 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
28 made in Article 33, Section 40 of Public Act 93-0842, as
29 amended, is reappropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
30 the Historic Preservation Agency to make Illinois Heritage
31 Grants for the purpose of planning, survey, rehabilitation,

1 restoration, reconstruction, landscaping and acquisition of
 2 Illinois properties designated on the National Register of
 3 Historic Places or as a landmark based on a county or
 4 municipal ordinance or those located within certain historic
 5 districts deemed historically significant.

6 Section 43. The amount of \$0 is appropriated from the
 7 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Historic Preservation
 8 Agency for a grant for the establishment of a civil rights
 9 museum.

10 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much
 11 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 12 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
 13 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
 14 Agency:

5 may be necessary is appropriated from the Illinois Historic
6 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the
7 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Administrative
8 Services division for costs associated with but not limited
9 to Union Station, the Old State Capitol and the Old Journal
10 Register Building.

11 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
13 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
14 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
15 Agency:

20 Section 60. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic
22 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for
23 operations, maintenance, repairs, permanent improvements,
24 special events, and all other costs related to the operation
25 of Illinois Historic Sites and only to the extent which
26 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites.

27 Section 65. The sum of \$196,300, or so much thereof as
28 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Historic
29 Preservation Agency from the General Revenue Fund for
30 programs and purposes including repairing, maintaining,
31 reconstructing, rehabilitating, replacing, fixed assets,
32 construction and development, studies, all costs for

1 supplies, materials, labor, land acquisition and its related
2 costs, services and other expenses at historic sites.

3 Section 70. The sum of \$236,850, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
5 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the operational
6 expenses of the Lewis and Clark Historic Site in Madison
7 County.

8 Section 75. The amounts appropriated for repairs and
9 maintenance and other capital improvements in Section 5b of
10 this Article for repairs and/or replacements, and
11 miscellaneous capital improvements at the agency's various
12 historical sites, and are to include construction,
13 reconstruction, improvements, repairs and installation of
14 capital facilities, costs of planning, supplies, materials,
15 and all other types of repairs and maintenance, and capital
16 improvements.

17 No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred
18 for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements
19 from appropriations made in Section 5c of this Article until
20 after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing
21 by the Governor.

23 Section 80. The sum of \$12,062,200, or so much thereof
24 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Presidential
25 Library and Museum Operating Fund to the Historic
26 Preservation Agency to meet the ordinary and contingent
27 expenses of the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and
28 Museum in Springfield.

30 Section 85. The following named sums, or so much thereof
31 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
32 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the

1 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
2 Agency:
