SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$10,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for: (1) treatment of methamphetamine addicts; (2) the prevention of beginning or continued usage of methamphetamine; (3) community outreach programs; and (4) education programs to teach public awareness of the dangers of methamphetamine use. Effective July 1, 2005.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for: (1)
7 treatment of methamphetamine addicts; (2) the prevention of
8 beginning or continued usage of methamphetamine; (3)
9 community outreach programs; and (4) education programs to
10 teach public awareness of the dangers of methamphetamine use.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
12 2005.
