Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act. Provides that the "adequate shelter and protection from the weather" that an owner is required to provide means an enclosed, roofed structure that acts as a windbreak and will allow the animal to retain its body heat.

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AN ACT concerning animals.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended bychanging Section 3 as follows:

- Sec. 3. Owner's duties. Each owner shall provide for each of his animals:
- 9 (a) sufficient quantity of good quality, wholesome 10 food and water;

(b) adequate shelter and protection from the weather, which means an enclosed, roofed structure that acts as a windbreak and will allow the animal to retain its body heat, such as a house, garage, or other insulated or heated structure;

16 (c) veterinary care when needed to prevent suffering; 17 and

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(d) humane care and treatment.

19 A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty of a 20 Class B misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation is a 21 Class 4 felony with every day that a violation continues 22 constituting a separate offense. In addition to any other 23 penalty provided by law, upon conviction for violating this Section, the court may order the convicted person to undergo a 24 25 psychological or psychiatric evaluation and to undergo any 26 treatment at the convicted person's expense that the court determines to be appropriate after due consideration of the 27 28 evaluation. If the convicted person is a juvenile or a companion animal hoarder, the court must order the convicted 29 30 person to undergo a psychological or psychiatric evaluation and to undergo treatment that the court determines to be 31 appropriate after due consideration of the evaluation. 32
