SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Medigap Premium Reimbursement Act. Establishes the Medigap Premium Reimbursement Program, to be administered by the Department of Public Aid. Provides that under the program, a person who is 65 years of age or older and who purchases and pays the premiums for a policy of Medicare supplemental ("Medigap") insurance that contains a prescription drug benefit is entitled to receive \$25 per month from the State for each month that he or she pays those premiums, as a reimbursement of a part of the cost of the insurance coverage.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT in relation to aging.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Medigap Premium Reimbursement Act.
- 6 Section 5. Reimbursement program. The Medigap Premium 7 Reimbursement Program is established. Under the program, a person who is 65 years of age or older and who purchases and 8 pays the premiums for a policy of Medicare supplemental 9 ("Medigap") insurance that contains a prescription drug 10 11 benefit is entitled to receive \$25 per month from the State for 12 each month that he or she pays those premiums, as a 13 reimbursement of a part of the cost of the insurance coverage. The Department of Public Aid shall administer the program and 14 15 shall adopt rules necessary to implement the program.
