Amend House Bill 4546, AS AMENDED, by 3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: "Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 5 6 adding Sections 10-1-15.1 and 10-2.1-31 as follows: 7 (65 ILCS 5/10-1-15.1 new)Sec. 10-1-15.1. Police officers, firefighters, and 8 paramedics; children of employees killed in the line of duty. 9 Any son or daughter of a firefighter, paramedic, or police 10

officer killed in the line of duty whose name appears on an 11 eligibility list for a position as a firefighter, paramedic, or 12 13 police officer in a municipality with a population of 1,000,000 or more and who passes all requirements for the position is 14 guaranteed to be hired from that eligibility list. A 15 16 municipality with a population of 1,000,000 or more may not regulate the hiring of firefighters, paramedics, or police 17 officers in a manner that is inconsistent with this Section. 18 This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 19

Sec. 10-2.1-31. Police officers, firefighters, and 1 paramedics; children of employees killed in the line of duty. 2 3 Any son or daughter of a firefighter, paramedic, or police officer killed in the line of duty whose name appears on an 4 5 eligibility list for a position as a firefighter, paramedic, or police officer in a municipality with a population of 1,000,000 6 7 or more and who passes all requirements for the position is guaranteed to be hired from that eligibility list. A 8 municipality with a population of 1,000,000 or more may not 9 regulate the hiring of firefighters, paramedics, or police 10 officers in a manner that is inconsistent with this Section. 11 This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 12 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent 13 exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised 14 15 by the State.

- 19 Sec. 8.30. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8 20 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of 21 the 94th General Assembly.". 22
